IT WAS THE MONTH OF...



December 1964 that the first open meeting to begin planning a library building for Cape Coral was sponsored by the Cape Coral Library Association. Prior to this the first library was housed in a storefront space on Cape Coral Parkway. The first library building was on Coronado Parkway and was chartered with the State as a non-profit organization.



DID YOU KNOW...

In 1821 Spain gave the United States title to Florida in exchange for America's relinquishment of all claims to Texas. Not a penny changed hands.

The Adams-Onís Treaty between the United States and Spain was negotiated by Secretary of State John Quincy Adams and the Spanish Minister to the United States, Don Luis de Onís.

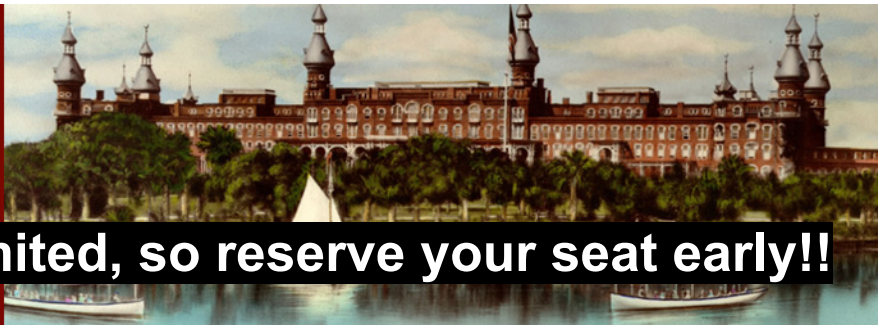
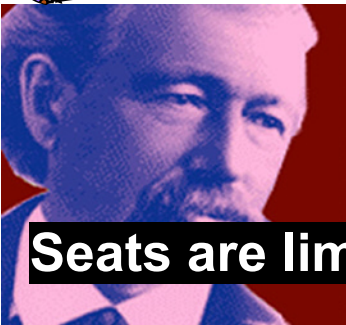
